

Blaufränkisch 2007

Designation: quality wine from the Neusiedlersee, in the Austrian region of Burgenland

Origin: grown in the Pannonian climate at the eastern side of Lake Neusiedl. The hot summer days provide optimum ripening conditions. The cool nights of late summer promote the development of a fruity bouquet and provide ideal conditions for a powerful red wine with intense fruit. Soils are sandy-loamy with small amounts of clay.

Vinification: grapes are hand-picked, fermented on the skins with natural yeasts from our own vineyards, partly in large casks, partly in stainless steel. A gentle immersion of the berries in the must increases extraction of colouring pigments and tannins; refined by malolactic fermentation.
