



- vineyards** 35 hectares (86.5 acres)
- varieties** 50% Grüner Veltliner, Riesling, Muskateller, Sauvignon Blanc, Traminer, Pinot Blanc, Zweigelt, Pinot Noir, Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot
- wine region kamptal** The name Kamptal refers to the Kamp river. This pictures beautiful area is filled with culture and tourism, which are enhanced by the numerous Heurigen, wine taverns and Vinotheques. Grüner Veltliner and Riesling are the main varieties of the Kamptal region.
- wine village langenlois** The family-run winery is situated in Austria's biggest wine growing village, Langenlois.
- our soil and climate** Loess with gravel, dynamics between the hot, Pannonian lain in the east and the cool Waldviertel to the northeast, interplay between hot days and cool nights confers great aromas and vigorous acidity to the grapes.
- production** Grüner Veltliner represents over 50% of the production. Grüner Veltliner can be found in different styles, from a light summer wine to powerful and voluminous full bodied wines as well as dessert wines and our speciality - the sparkling wines which are produced according to the traditional bottle fermenting method.
